# LEARN TO SKATE AT *The Rink at Warwick*

The Rink at Warwick would like to welcome you to our Learn to Skate program! Over the years, our Learn to Skate program has taught thousands of our community's skaters.



**Basic Skills:** The USFS basic skills skating programs guides new skaters through carefully graduated maneuvers, ensuring rapid progress over short time periods. Basic 1-8 tests provide direction and build competency in all important foundation moves. forward and backward skating, stopping, turning and edges are taught in exciting, low cost group lessons.

**Freestyle:** The freestyle levels are designed to give skaters a strong foundation upon which to build their skills. This is the point where the skater can choose whether to pursue a recreational or competitive approach to the sport of figure skating.

**Moms & Tots:** This program is an opportunity for Parents and their children to learn how to skate together. We will focus on the basic skating coordination in order to move to the USFS Basic Skills levels. *Only on Tuesdays for \$160 total for both mom & tot.*
